
- Forbid to use it in high temperature, high humidity environment, especially in the bathroom with high temperature. 0~40°C is the best working temperature for DVR.




### Loading & Unloading of Sunshade Cover

#### Loading & Unloading Methods of Sunshade Cover

The bottom of sunshade cover is provided with 2 buckle pins. Please aim them at the button holes on DVR and push gently; it's loaded in place. If need to unload it, just gently push it to the opposite direction.

Open operation of the sunshade cover: just push up the button in the middle of cover; it pop open.



### How to Charge

1. Notice before operation

Battery capacity symbols:



Tips: The possible reason for being unable to power on DVR is battery running out. Please operate it after charging by AC adapter or PC.

2. How to charge

Charge 4~6 hours for fully charged. Unplug the charger until the battery status is full.

Notice:

- A. This charger is for this machine use only. Do not leave the charger in humid place. Unplug the charger and keep it well after charging. Do not repair, break down or remake the charger.
- B. For better performance, please charge the brand new machine for more than 6 but less than 10 hours for the first time. New battery will reach best performance after a few times full charge and discharge.
- C.If no need to use in a long time, it's recommended to charge the DVR every 2~3 months and then keep it after switch off.

# **Basic Operation**

1. Power On/Off:

Press "O" to power on, DVR is on working state; long time press "O" again to power it off.

#### 2. Working mode switch (switcher located at the left corner):

When it switches to "", DVR is in state of receiving/record;

When it switches to "DVR is in the state of take photo;

When it switches to "• DVR is in the state of playback.

#### 3. Automatic scanning to lock channel

The DVR is in "auto" scan mode default. Press "③"start scan from A1 to D8 one by one, then it locks the strongest signal channels. Please press "④"/"<sup>1</sup>" to choose and lock the channel.

#### 4. External Storage card

Only after storage card being plugged in, this DVR can record, photo. Screen will show symbol of SD card & its left capacity.

#### 5. Working as a U-disk

Connect DVR to computer and power it on, it will work as a U-disk. Open the removable disk in the computer, you'll find the videos and photos in "RECORD" and "PHOTO" files under "DICM" directory.

### **Record & Photo**

Power DVR on, and select working mode to """, it is in recording/photo mode.

**1. Record:** Under " $\overset{\frown}{\square}$ " mode, press " $\overset{\frown}{\square}$ ", DVR start to record, and screen shows "REC". Press " $\overset{\frown}{\square}$ " again to pause, screen shows "II"; press " $\overset{\frown}{\square}$ " one more time, it continue to record. Press " $\overset{\frown}{\square}$ " to end, it will save automatically and exit. If not press " $\overset{\frown}{\square}$ ", the system will automatically save video in segments until storage card is full.



2. Photo: Under "O" mode, press "O" once, screen flashes once, and get one picture.



## **Record & Photo**

While if "Overwrite" is turn on, not press "••" to end recording, system will automatically save video in segments. And when the card is full, it will overwrite the earliest recording and save the latest one, keep cycle recording.

3. Mute/Sound: Under "⇔" mode, it is mute, press "●" to enter state of sound. Press "●" again Screen displays "MUTE". Speaker no sound;

Note: Mute setting will not affect earphone.




#### **Play Video/Photo**

When working mode selected to "**O**", it's in the mode of play video & photo. Press "**M**" / "**W**" to select "Photo" or "Video". Press "**D**" to exit and back to main menu.



2. Play Photos: Select "Photo", and press "<sup>©</sup>" to enter into photo files. Press "<sup>®</sup>" / "<sup>®</sup>" to select pictures, then press "<sup>©</sup>" to view. Press "<sup>®</sup>" to view next one; press "<sup>®</sup>" to view previous one. Press "<sup>©</sup>" to exit.

1. Channel Setting: Press "♥" / "♥" to select "Channel Setting", and then press "♥" to enter. Press "♥" / "♥" to select "A,B,C,D" then press "♥" to select and exit.



2. Recorder Resolution: Press<sup>™</sup> <sup>™</sup> <sup>™</sup> <sup>™</sup> <sup>™</sup> to select " Recorder Resolution" and press <sup>™</sup> <sup>™</sup> <sup>™</sup> to enter. Press <sup>™</sup> <sup>™</sup> <sup>™</sup> <sup>™</sup> <sup>™</sup> <sup>™</sup> to select "720X576" / "720X480". Press <sup>™</sup> <sup>™</sup> <sup>™</sup> to confirm & exit.

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**3. Frame Rate:** Press "!!! / "!!!" to select "Frame Rate" and press "!!" to enter. Press "!!" to select "30 FPS"/"25 FPS", and press "!!" to confirm & exit.

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**4. Video Segment Sizes:** Press "🐨" / "🕨" to select "Video Segment Sizes", then press "🐨" to enter. Press "🐨" / "🗭" to select "10 MIN"/"30MIN"/"60 MIN". Press "🐨" to confirm & exit.

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5. Overwrite: Press """""""" to select "Overwrite", and press """" to enter. Press """""" to select "Off"/"On", and press """" to confirm & exit. If "Overwrite" is on, DVR will cycle record, and save the latest video.



6. Time Stamp: Press "🐨" / "🐨" to select "Time Stamp", and press "💁" to enter. Press "🐨" / "🐨" to select "Off"/ "On", and press "🖨" to confirm & exit. If it's on, video will be saved with synchronous time.



7. Information Display: Press " "/" " to select "Information Display", and press " " to enter. Press " " / " " to select "Off"/ "On", and press " " to confirm & exit. If it's on, screen will display information of working frequency, channel, audio state, date & time, etc. If select "Off", all the information will not be displayed.



8. Video Setting: Press "🐨" / "🗭" to select "Video Setting", and press "🐨" to enter. Press "🐨" / "🗭" to select "Brightness" or "Contrast"; then press "🐨" to enter; then press "🐨" / "🗭" to adjust brightness or contrast. Press "🖜" to exit



Power DVR on, working mode switched to "", press "" to enter into function & system setting. Press "" / "" to select "System"; then press "" to enter into system menu.

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**3. AV Out:** Press "**W**" / "**W**" to choose "AV Out", and press "**Q**" to enter. Press "**W**" / "**W**" to choose "PAL/NTSC", Press "**Q**" to confirm video displayed on TV screen. Pull out AV cable, video will back to DVR screen.



4. Format: Press """ / "" " to select "Format", and press "" to enter. Press "" / "" " to choose "Yes". Press "" to confirm & exit.



5. Power Save: Press "🖼 " / "🖼 " to select "Power Save", and press "🖬" to enter:



1)Auto LCD Off: Press "S"" to select "Auto LCD Off", and press "O" to enter. Press "S" / "W" to select "1 MIN"/ "5 MIN"/ "Off", and press "O" to confirm & exit. If turn on "Auto LCD Off", LCD screen will automatically shut off when the set time is due. Press any key to recover screen display.



2) Auto Power Off: Press "<sup>10</sup>", "<sup>10</sup>" to select "Auto Power Off", and press "<sup>10</sup>" to enter. Press "<sup>10</sup>", "<sup>10</sup>", "<sup>10</sup> MIN", "Off", and press "<sup>10</sup>" to confirm & exit. If turn on "Auto Power Off", DVR will automatically shut off when the set time is due.

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**6. Firmware Update:** Press "**G**" / "**D**" to select "Firmware Update", and press "**G**" to enter. Press "**G**" / "**D**" to select "Yes", and press "**G**" to start update. Please remember to save update file "zburnT C11.run.elf" at root directory of SD card.



7. Default Setup: Press "🐨 "/" 🖼 " to select "Default Setup", and press " 🐨 " to enter. Press " 🐨 " / " 🖼 " to select "Yes" and press " 🐨 " to confirm. Press " 🗢 " to exit.



8. Memory Info: Press<sup>™</sup> "/<sup>™</sup> " to select "Memory Info", and press "<sup>™</sup> " to view capacity of SD card. Press "<sup>™</sup> " to exit. \_\_\_\_\_





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### **Trouble Shooting**

Trouble Shooting:

- 1 It can't power on: Maybe no power. Recharging the DVR is ok;
- 2 System halted: Press the RESET key to turn on player again;
- 3 It can not play: Maybe the format of video file is not supported by this DVR, please convert it into the supported format.
- 4 The text is in messy code: Make sure the correct language is selected.
- 5 It can't upload / download files or can't find the disk in PC: Replace USB cable/USB port.
- 6 It can not save file: SD card is not in DVR, please insert SD card; or SD card memory is full, please delete some files to release memory; or there is damaged area in memory, please format it.
